



Executive MPA Scholarships 2019



The Hertie School of Governance in Berlin provides a number of scholarships for exceptional applicants to the **Executive Master of Public Administration** programme. The scholarship recipients will be selected based on the quality of the application, the candidate's contribution to the diversity of the student body as well as the financial need of the candidate.

- The **Central and Eastern European (CEE) Scholarship** is directed at professionals from all sectors from Central and Eastern European countries (including the Western Balkans) as well as employees of NISPAcee member institutions. It consists of a full tuition waiver for the Executive MPA programme.
- The **CommIO Scholarship** is directed at German professionals from international organisations or European institutions who are registered with CommIO. It is offered in partnership with the Auswärtiges Amt (German Federal Foreign Office) and consists of a 50% tuition waiver for the Executive MPA programme.
- The **Public Service Leaders Scholarship** is directed at professionals from the public sector (including national and state administrations, international organisations and European institutions) with proven leadership experience. It covers 50% of the tuition fees for the Executive MPA programme.
- The **Parliamentary Scholarship** is directed at heads of office and advisors of elected members of the German Federal Parliament as well as the European Parliament. It covers 50% of the tuition fees for the Executive MPA programme.
- The **Social Entrepreneurship and Non-Profit Management Scholarship** is directed at social entrepreneurs as well as at managers in the non-profit sector with proven leadership experience. It covers 50% of the tuition fees for the Executive MPA programme.
- The **Women in Leadership Scholarship** is directed at female professionals with proven leadership experience in all sectors. It covers 50% of the tuition fees for the Executive MPA programme.
- In addition to these scholarships, we also offer **financial aid** (partial tuition waivers ranging predominantly from 10-50% of the tuition fees).

Apply by 1 May for the programme start in September 2019.
