### 2 Apply for 'vision' presentation (optional)

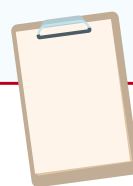
Do you have a vision of the future of healthcare? If you wish to present your vision of future health to other experts attending the conference apply with your idea (an abstract and your CV). All presentations will have to be in Pecha Kucha format. This step is not mandatory to attend the conference.

Send your application to [future-health@hertie-school.org](mailto:future-health@hertie-school.org) by **31 July 2022**. A jury of digital health and health policy experts from India and Germany will review the applications and select the six visions to be part of the conference.

### 3 Attend the conference and present your vision

Selected presenters will give a Pecha Kucha on their future vision at the 'Future of Healthcare' conference on **October 18** in New Delhi.

Each presentation will get a slot of 30 minutes (6:40 minutes for the Pecha Kucha, 20 minutes for discussions with the audience).



### Alumni Selection Criteria

- Funding for 10 alumni from DAC countries and 10 from non-DAC countries (only non-German Hertie School Alumni, living outside Germany. Please indicate your nationality and place of residence in your application)
- Gender balance
- Relevant professional experience in healthcare, health policy, AI and data science
- Motivation to support the international alumni network
- Priority will be given to alumni who are willing to offer internships, professional year positions or master thesis projects to current students. Please indicate this in your letter
